We have been sharing about God's desire to provide for you.

We are in one of the most difficult times in history.

God's word is our hand book for life.

As we have shared, people can except salvation but they do not put The Lord in charge of their finance.

He wants to be Lord of all including your finance

He wants to direct your decisions on what you do with the money He's given you and entrusted you with.

So here,

I'm getting several requests for money every day.

If I ask them what does God's word says about Him supplying all of your needs, almost every one of them say's, give to the poor.

The Word doesn't say give everything we have to the poor. Our job is to teach them God's way in finance.

They have not learned to make The Lord their source ... not people. We are not to be their source ... That's God's place.

Most of them have never learned to trust The Lord and His word that He will supply ALL THEIR NEEDS ...

If we keep giving them handouts we're playing God's role.

They will not learn to seek The Lord for their needs if we play God's role.

Our welfare system here in New Zealand can be people's source and people just go to the welfare to give them whatever they need.

They have made the welfare their source instead of The Lord.

His word says He doesn't want His children begging for bread, that means for their needs to be met by any other source than HIM. The sad thing here is many of these people contacting us have gone to seminaries to train to be leaders and pastors, but do not know what the word says about money.

Some have been told this teaching is not good.

It's deception and misleading and so they have not bothered to check it out for themselves.

I have walked it out now for 25 years and I can tell you it works. I have learned to make the word top priority and I work the word, read the word out loud several times a day for our provision.

It's like filling up a well and it will overflow.

It's a lifestyle change.
